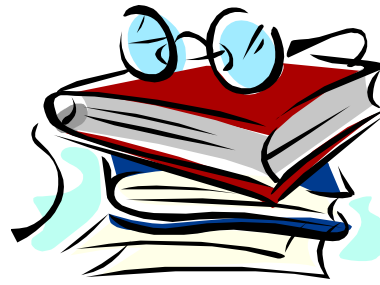


GRAY MATTER CHALLENGE '18

How the Challenge Works: Select 4 students to represent your school. Each student is to be assigned 4 categories from the list on the CATEGORIES FORM, in which to compete. Each of your students will compete against 1 student from each of the other participating schools in each category. The host will read a question and the student must record their answers within 20 seconds. 12 seconds are given for Human Calculator questions and answers are not revealed till all questions are complete. A question can only be repeated once, when a participant requests it, immediately following the reading of it. Once they are told to do so by the host, the students will hold up their answers for the scorekeepers to see. Have your students write their answers as large as possible. The host will reveal the answer and a point will be awarded for each correct answer. The school that accumulates the most correct answers by the end of the 17 rounds will be declared the Gray Matter Champion. If students are participating in a designated Lifeline match, the host will indicate to students not to reveal their answers until the Lifeline process is complete. Round 17 only counts towards the school's overall score and not the student involved.

NEW Category 17 - Collaboration: In this category all members of the team will collaborate to answer the questions. Team members can be quiet or talk openly. No help can come from those not participating in the challenge.

Lifelines: For each designated Lifeline round students are entitled to only 1 Lifeline. A Lifeline can be any other predetermined teammate. These teammates will sit on reserved chairs to the side of the stage before the round begins and stay there until it is finished. If a participant wishes to use a Lifeline s/he will hold up the card labelled lifeline within the 20 seconds allotted for the answer. The teammate will come up to the front and whisper the answer to the participant who will then record an answer. The host will then ask everybody to hold up their answers. Teammates are not permitted to indicate to the participant that they know the answer or the lifeline will be rescinded. The participant will give his/her Lifeline card to the scorekeeper.

Integrity: Please inform all participants to play with integrity and respect the rules of the game. No methods should be used to aid the participant in answering the questions. If you are suspicious of teams breaking the rules then please come and see me or the person responsible for that school. When up front avoid glancing at other answers.

How to Enter: There will be an entry fee of \$7.00 per school. Cheques are to be made out to MESAA. Challenge starts at 9:45. Fill out the forms that will be sent to your school a few weeks before the event. Submit the names of the participants and the categories they will be participating in by Friday, April 27, 2018. Please make sure that after the entry forms have been returned that no changes be made. Individual keeper medals will be awarded as well as a medal for the individual who answered the most correct answers in all his/her categories.
